FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER


By Decision No. 49649, dated February 9, 1954, the Commission authorized Alma Middleton Akins to transfer certain operative rights and properties to Harry Wendell. The order of the Commission provides for the withdrawal or cancellation of rates, rules and regulations by Alma Middleton Akins and the adoption or establishment of the same by Harry Wendell within 60 days after the effective date of the Commission's order.

The Commission is informed that applicant Wendell has not yet completed registration of the operating authority with the Interstate Commerce Commission and that because of the delay applicants have been unable to complete the tariff changes within the time set by the Commission's order. Accordingly, they request an extension of time to meet the Commission's requirements.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that an extension of time should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time within which Alma Middleton Akins may withdraw or cancel his rates, rules and

regulations and Harry Wendell may adopt or establish the same, as authorized by Decision No. 49649, dated February 9, 1954, be, and it hereby is, extended to and including July 31, 1954.
