ORDER

County of Napa is authorized to construct Airport Road, Darms Lane and Hoffman Lane at grade across Calistoga Branch Line of Southern Pacific Company, Airport Road being near the City of Napa, Napa County and Darms Lane and Hoffman Lane being near Yountville, Napa County, at the locations described in the application to be identified as Crossings Nos. AB-63.9, AB-75.2 and AB-76.7, respectively. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossings shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than four percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. 0. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B) at each location designated.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year

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unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
