ORDER

The verified application of Southern Pacific Company, filed on April 29, 1954, discloses that the switching limits of Santa Cruz Station, an agency station located 1.9 miles west of Orby Station, have been extended to include Orby Station and that, therefore, continued maintenance of Orby Station is not necessary.

Good cause appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its Class "D" non-agency station of Orby, County of Santa Cruz; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
