FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 48876, dated July 28, 1953, the Commission authorized Harold R. Geister and Melvin A. Geister to issue a promissory note, on or before December 31, 1953, in the principal amount of \$28,000 for the purpose of refinancing outstanding indebtedness and of providing the cost of construction, and to execute a deed of trust.


Applicants now report that through inadvertence they issued the note and executed the deed of trust during March of 1954, which was subsequent to the expiration of the authority granted by the Commission, and they request that the Commission extend the effective date of Decision No. 48876 to May 31, 1954. However, the Commission cannot now approve the execution of instruments heretofore accomplished without authorization of the Commission then in effect, and we are of the opinion that applicants should issue a new note and execute a new deed of trust to replace those issued and executed without Commission authorization; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Harold R. Geister and Melvin A. Geister may issue a promissory note and execute a deed of trust, on or before July 31, 1954, to replace the promissory note and deed of trust authorized by Decision No. 48876, dated July 28, 1953, but


executed after the expiration of such authorization, said note and deed of trust to be in, or substantially in, the same form as those filed with the original application in this proceeding. Applicants shall use the proceeds from the issue of the note for the purposes set forth in said Decision No. 48876.

This first supplemental order will become effective upon the date hereof.
