ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

It appearing by Decision No. 38464, dated December 10, 1945, in Application No. 27077, that Riverside Transit Lines, a California corporation, was authorized to acquire from W. Paul Butler the certificates of public convenience and necessity granted by Decisions Nos. 34756 and 35514 for the operation of a passenger stage service in the City of Riverside and vicinity; and it further appearing by Decision No. 47065, dated April 29, 1952, in Applications Nos. 31525 and 31959 as amended, that said Riverside Transit Lines was found to have discontinued its passenger stage operations due to financial difficulties and loss of its operating equipment; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity transferred to Riverside Transit Lines by Decision No. 38464 in the above-entitled proceeding, as modified by Decision No. 39664 in Application No. 27834, is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables filed on behalf of Riverside Transit Lines are hereby cancelled.

The Secretary of the Commission is hereby directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon Riverside Transit Lines in the manner prescribed by law.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after lawful service thereof upon Riverside Transit Lines, unless said Riverside Transit Lines before such effective date shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order, denying the facts set forth herein and requesting public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order will thereby be stayed until hearing is held and further order issued.
