Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a side track at grade across State Route 64, in the County of Riverside, at the location described in the application as - amended June 9, 1954, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. B-613.0. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72 and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) supplemented with automatic short-arm gates.

Within 30 days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.
