## SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 50114 of June 1, 1954, in this proceeding, establishes Minimum Rate Tariff No. 11-A naming minimum rates, rules and regulations for the transportation of uncrated new furniture, effective July 1, 1954. The decision requires that tariff publications of common carriers be made effective on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public. The Motor Truck Association of Southern California requests that the time for complying with the tariff requirements be amended so as to allow publication on one day's notice.

Petitioner states that there are highway common carriers engaged in the transportation of uncrated new furniture who now publish rates in their tariffs on a per-piece or per-article basis while the Tariff No. 11-A rates are on a weight basis. It alleges that because of these differences changes will have to be made carefully in complying with the minimum rate order. It further alleges that it was not possible to file tariffs on ten days' notice and make them effective July 1, 1954.

Interested parties have been notified of the filing of the petition. No objection has been offered to its being granted.

In the circumstances, it appears that the sought authority should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary. Inasmuch as Tariff No. 11-A becomes effective July 1, 1954, the order herein will be made effective immediately.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that ordering paragraph (2) of Decision No. 50114 of June 1, 1954, be and it is hereby amended by substituting "one day's" for "ten days'."

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the second ordering paragraph of Decision No. 50175 of June 18, 1954, be and it is hereby amended by substituting "one day's" for "five days'."

In all other respects Decisions Nos. 50114 and 50175, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
