## FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 48746 of June 23, 1953, William E. Hibbitt and David Macaulay, partners doing business as Lawrence Warehouse & Distributing Co., were authorized to suspend for one year the operation of 27,550 square feet of warehouse space in Sacramento. A one-year extension of this authority is sought.

Applicants allege that they have attempted to obtain suitable replacement space but will be unable to secure it prior to July 13, 1954, the expiration date of the present suspension authority.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the sought extension should be granted.
Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the expiration date of the authority granted William E. Hibbitt and David Macaulay, partners doing business as Lawrence Warehouse & Distributing Co., by Decision No. 48746 of June 23, 1953, in this proceeding, be and it

is hereby extended to July 13, 1955, unless sooner changed or further extended by order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective July 13, 1954.
