Application of the County of Siskiyou)
 to construct crossing at point three)
 miles north of Montague city limit) Application No. 35322
 along Southern Pacific Railroad line.)

O R D E R

County of Siskiyou is authorized to construct Shelley Road at grade across Shasta Route (Siskiyou) Line of Southern Pacific Company near Montague, Siskiyou County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. C-379.0. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-four feet and grades of approach not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. 75-B), reflectorized with reflex-reflecting material.

Upon completion, a private railroad grade crossing located about 400 feet northerly shall be abandoned and closed. Also upon completion, Crossing No. C-380.6 located about 1.6 miles northerly shall be closed to public use. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The County of Siskiyou is highly desirous to complete the construction of proposed

Crossing No. C-379.0 before the beginning of the fall school semester and they request authorization as soon as possible. Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
