FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant transports property for General Mills, Inc., Sperry Division, between points in southern California. He has been authorized to observe monthly vehicle unit rates in lieu of the minimum rates in cents per 100 pounds otherwise applicable to this transportation. The authority is scheduled to expire August 4, 1954. Its extension until July 31, 1955 is now sought. Applicant proposes to charge increased monthly rates which he is now assessing under an agreement with the shipper.

The supplemental application shows that, except for increased operating costs, the conditions surrounding the transportation in question which justified deviation from the minimum rates still obtain. It also shows that the higher costs have been offset by the increases made in the monthly rates and that operations under these rates may reasonably be expected to be conducted on a profitable basis for the ensuing year.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the supplemental application should be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,





IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 47484 of July 15, 1952, as amended, be and it is hereby further amended by substituting

in Item No. 15 of Appendix "A" attached thereto "730" for "715", "960" for "945", "18" for "17", and "30" for "29".

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the expiration date of the authority granted by said Decision No. 47484, as further amended herein, be and it is hereby extended to July 31, 1955, unless sooner changed or further extended by order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
