Application of CENTRAL CALIFORNIA TRACTION COMPANY under Section 7613 of the California Public Utilities Code for relief in connection with the requirements of Section 7612 of said Code.

ORDER

Central California Traction Company on July 2, 1954, under Section 7613 of the California Public Utilities Code, filed with the Commission a request for an extension of time of SIX (6) MONTHS FROM July 1, 1954, within which to comply with the provisions of Section 7612 of said Code which requires the installation of windshields and other equipment on rail track motor cars.

Applicant alleges that the manufacturer of the windshields and other equipment suitable for its rail track motor cars has received a large number of orders and by reason of this unusual volume has not been able to furnish the same in time for applicant to fully comply with the requirements of the law, but it believes it can have such installations completed by December 31, 1954. The rail-road operating brotherhoods involved do not oppose this application.

It appears that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the request is reasonable and should be granted, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the time limit within which Central California Traction Company shall comply with the provisions of Section 7612 of the Public Utilities Code is extended to and including December 31, 1954.
