OPINION AND ORDER

Pacific Water Co. has filed this application for authorization to execute a deed of trust.

Applicant is engaged, among other things, in the operation of the East Bakersfield Water System in Kern County. It reports that in order to provide an additional source of supply it has made arrangements to purchase a parcel of land and to drill an additional well. The sale price of the land is \$4,000, payable \$1,000 down and the balance in 90 days. The deferred payment will be represented by a promissory note, payable on or before October 10, 1954, and secured by a deed of trust covering the property.

The Commission has given consideration to this application, and is of the opinion that a public hearing is not necessary and that the request of applicant to execute the deed of trust should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. Pacific Water Co. may execute a deed of trust in, or substantially in, the same form as that filed in this proceeding

as Exhibit B, for the purpose indicated herein.

2. Applicant shall file with the Commission a statement showing the action taken by it under the authorization herein granted, such statement to be filed on or before October 31, 1954.

3. The authority herein granted will become effective upon the date hereof.
