O R D E R

Fullerton Union High School District and Fullerton Junior College District are authorized to construct three pedestrian crossings at grade across the Fullerton Line of Pacific Electric Railway Company in the City of Fullerton, Orange County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as Crossings Nos. 6CB-26.72-D for the northerly crossing, 6CB-26.76-D for the center crossing, and 6CB-26.81-D for the southerly crossing. Applicants shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Pacific Electric Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossings shall be not more than 10 feet and grades of approach not greater than two per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 1 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by installation of suitable post barricades so spaced as to prevent access to these crossings by motor vehicles.

Any request for permission to construct underground utility service connections in the right of way beneath the track should be made to the railway in the first instance.

Within 30 days after completion pursuant to this order applicants shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
