O R D E R

The verified application of The Western Pacific Railroad Company, filed on June 18, 1954, discloses that the amount of passenger and freight business transacted at applicant's station of Fitz during a recent 16-month period no longer warrants its continued maintenance, particularly since the construction project which caused the freight to move has now been completed.

Good cause appearing, The Western Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Fitz, County of San Joaquin; to remove a side track at said station; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
