Application of Peerless Stages, Incorporated, a corporation for authority to operate bus service over a new alternate route between the Town of Warm Springs and the City of San Jose. )

) Application No. 35548

O P I N I O N

Applicant, Peerless Stages, Inc., presently rendering a passenger stage service between Oakland and San Jose, among other points, seeks authority to operate an alternate route for through traffic only, between the Town of Warm Springs and the City of San Jose.

By Decision No. 48791, dated July 7, 1953, in Application No. 34440 applicant was authorized to operate over the Eastshore Freeway to Jackson Street in the Town of Mt. Eden. By Decision No. 49069, dated September 15, 1953, in Application No. 34647 applicant was authorized to operate between the Town of Mt. Eden and the Hayward Niles Road via Harder Road. Applicant alleges that a new portion of the Eastshore Freeway has been completed between the Town of Warm Springs and the City of San Jose. The extension would assertedly expedite service on express schedules between Oakland and San Jose.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion and so finds that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the authority sought. A public hearing is unnecessary.

O R D E R

Application having been filed, the Commission being informed in the premises and it having been found that public convenience and necessity so require,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That Route No. 1 between Oakland and San Jose as described in Decision No. 35763 in Application No. 25206 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following, subject to the restriction that no passengers may be picked up or discharged along said route:

Commencing at the intersection of State Highways 21 and 17 (known as Warm Springs Junction) thence along the Eastshore Freeway, Gish Road, 4th Street to East Santa Clara Street (in the City of San Jose).

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
