## FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Haslett Warehouse Company transports tobacco and cigarettes for the R. J. Reynolds Tobaceo Co. between certain points in the East Bay drayage area. By Decision No. 49582 of January 18, 1954, in this proceeding, it was authorized to observe rates less than the minimum rates otherwise applicable to this transportation. The authority is scheduled to expire Lugust 7, 2954. Permission is sought to continue to deviate from the minimum rates for a further one-year period.

The supplemental application shows that in general the conditions surrounding the transportation in question which justified deviation from the minimum rates still obtain and that operations under the authorized rates have been compensatory.

Interested parties have been notified of the filing of the supplemental application. No objection to its being granted has been received.

In the circumstances it appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the supplemental application should be granted. To prevent a lapse of applicant's authority, the order herein will be made effective August 7, 1954.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the expiration date of the authority granted Haslett Warehouse Company by Decision No. 49582 of January 18, 2954, in this proceeding, be and it is hereby extended so august 7, 2955; unless sooner canceled, changed or extended by order of the Commission.
