O R D E R

County of Siskiyou is authorized to construct Sheep Mountain Road at grade across Shasta Route (Cascade) Main Line of Southern Pacific Company near Somerset, Siskiyou County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. CF-397.9. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than four per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflecting material.

Upon completion, the present traveled-way grade crossing located about 75 feet southerly shall be abandoned and closed. Also upon completion, Crossing No. CF-397.4 located about 0.5 miles southerly shall be abandoned and closed. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or

modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.
The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date
hereof.
