O R D E R

Applicant has requested an order requiring the closing of a grade crossing involving a publicly-used road and the double-track main line of Southern Pacific Company at Mile Post 13.1 in Millbrae, San Mateo County. It appearing that the two principal users of this crossing are agreeable to the closing thereof, having made plans for other access to their properties, public hearings are thereby not necessary and it further appearing that public interest requires the granting of the application,

IT IS ORDERED that said crossing be closed by Southern Pacific Company by construction of barriers in such manner as effectively to prevent the use thereof by vehicular traffic.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within thirty days after said crossing is so closed applicant shall give the Commission written notice of its compliance with the terms hereof.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
