O R D E R

Applicant has requested an order authorizing it to abandon and remove its stock corrals at Berenda, Madera County. It appearing that the several parties having possible interest in this proposal are not opposed to it, one party having withdrawn an objection with the understanding that applicant will continue to provide and maintain stock corrals at Daulton (Madera County), and that, thereby, a public hearing is unnecessary; and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon and remove said stock corrals.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
