ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By its complaint in this proceeding, the State of California, Department of Public Works, alleges that the defendant railroad corporation assessed and collected for the transportation of numerous carloads of crushed rock, rock screenings, sand and crushed rock coated with liquid asphalt charges higher than those specified in the applicable tariffs and greater than authorized by the Commission under Sections 454 and 734 of the Public Utilities Code.

The Commission is advised that the complaint has been adjusted and complainant has requested in writing that the matter be dismissed.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above-entitled complaint of the State of California, Department of Public Works, be and it is hereby dismissed.
