ORDER CONTINUING IN EFFECT ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIONS

By Decision No. 48689, dated June 9, 1953, on Application No. 34276, Lyle V. Scott was given authority to suspend his passenger stage operations between San Bernardino, on the one hand, and the Victorville Army Air Base (also known as George Air Force Base), and Air Base Housing Project, on the other hand, for a period of one year from June 9, 1953. By the first supplemental application herein he has requested that this Commission extend the order of suspension for an additional period of one year or less pending the building of housing facilities at George Air Force Base.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That Lyle V. Scott is hereby authorized to suspend for one year from and including June 9, 1954, passenger stage operations between San Bernardino, on the one hand, and Victorville Army Air Base (also known as George Air Force Base) and Air Base Housing Project, on the other hand.

(2) That Lyle V. Scott shall file supplements to his tariff and timetables in triplicate, indicating the suspension of service
