O P I N I O N

Applicants now are authorized to operate a passenger stage service between San Pedro and the Hollywood Park Race Track (Decision No. 50042).

By the application authority is requested to establish and operate a similar service between San Pedro and the Santa Anita Race Track.⁽¹⁾

Proposed stops and fares are as follows:

Anaheim Boulevard and Figueroa Street	2.50
Anaheim Boulevard and Main Street	
(Wilmington Boulevard)	2.50
Anaheim Boulevard and Avalon Boulevard	2.25
Avalon Boulevard and Sepulveda Boulevard	2.25

No local service between intermediate points is contemplated. The equipment will consist of one bus similar to that which is now used to provide service to Hollywood Park.

Applicant states that many race track patrons live in the areas proposed to be served and that sufficient patronage will be

available for a profitable operation. Applicants are experienced bus operators and financial statements filed with the application show that they are able to establish and maintain the proposed service.

The application is not opposed and will be granted. A public hearing is not deemed necessary.

O R D E R

Application having been made, the Commission being fully advised in the premises and finding that public convenience and necessity so require,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity be, and it hereby is, granted to Frank Mannino and Dominic Mannino authorizing the establishment and operation of a service as a passenger stage corporation as defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code, for the transportation of passengers between San Pedro, on the one hand, and Santa Anita Race Track, in Arcadia, on the other hand, subject to the following restrictions:

- (a) The transportation service herein authorized shall be rendered only when thoroughbred horse racing is conducted at Santa Anita Race Track.
- (b) Passengers shall be picked up or discharged at the following intersections or points only:

5th Street and Harbor Boulevard (San Pedro),
6th Street and Pacific Avenue (San Pedro),
Anaheim Boulevard and Gaffey Street, Western
Avenue and Pacific Coast Highway, Pacific
Coast Highway and Normandie Avenue, Anaheim
Boulevard and Figueroa Street, Anaheim
Boulevard and Main Street (Wilmington Boulevard),
Anaheim Boulevard and Avalon Boulevard, Avalon
Boulevard and Sepulveda Boulevard.

(2) That in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted there shall be compliance with the following service regulations:

- (a) Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted.
- (b) Within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and upon not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate and concurrently make effective tariffs and time schedules satisfactory to the Commission.
- (c) Subject to the authority of this Commission to change or modify such at any time, Frank Mannino and Dominic Mannino shall conduct said passenger stage operations over and along the following described route:

Beginning at the intersection of 5th and Harbor Boulevard in San Pedro, thence along Harbor Boulevard, 6th Street, Gaffey Street, Anaheim Boulevard, Western Avenue, Pacific Coast Highway, Normandie Avenue, Anaheim Boulevard, Avalon Boulevard, Sepulveda Boulevard, Wilmington Avenue, Del Amo Boulevard, Santa Fe Avenue, Artesia Street Lakewood Boulevard, Rosemead Boulevard, and Huntington Drive to entrance of race track and return via same route.

Applicant is authorized to turn its motor vehicles at termini and intermediate points, in either direction, at intersections of streets or by operating around a block contiguous to such intersections, or in accordance with local traffic rules.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
