SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 50317 of July 27, 1954, in this proceeding, granted applicants a sixty-day extension of their present authority to deviate from the minimum rates for the transportation of potatoes and onions from packing sheds located within 30 miles of Stockton to rail cars and connecting truck lines for loading. Applicants had sought a one-year extension of the authority with certain modifications. The limited extension of the present authority was granted pending further investigation.

Subsequently, applicants showed that the authorized rates have been compensatory and that with the sought modifications the operations may be expected to continue to be profitable during the ensuing year.

Interested parties have been notified of the filing of the supplemental application. No objection to its being granted has been received.

In the circumstances it appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the sought modification and extension of applicants' authority is justified and should be granted. Inasmuch as the shipping season for the commodities involved has already begun and so that applicants may start operating under the modified authority as soon as possible, the order herein will be made effective immediately.
