ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

It appearing by Decision No. 47237, dated June 5, 1952, in Application No. 33149, that Martinez Bus Lines, Inc. was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the establishment and operation of a passenger stage service for the transportation of passengers between points within the City of Martinez and adjacent suburban areas.

It further appearing by a letter dated July 22, 1954 from the above carrier that, due to continued financial difficulties, it can no longer render such service.

And it further appearing, after investigation by this Commission, that the above carrier has discontinued operation of said service without obtaining the requisite authority.

Therefore, it is found that Martinez Bus Lines, Inc. is no longer conducting and has unlawfully abandoned said passenger stage service.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Martinez Bus Lines, Inc. by Decision No. 47237 in the above-entitled proceeding is hereby revoked, and all effective tariffs and timetables filed on behalf of said carrier are hereby canceled.

The Secretary of the Commission is hereby directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon Martinez Bus Lines, Inc.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after lawful service of a copy hereof upon Martinez Bus Lines, Inc., unless said Martinez Bus Lines, Inc. before such effective date shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order, denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order will thereby be stayed until hearing is held and further order issued.
