SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

It appearing that ordering paragraph (1) of Decision No. 50398, dated August 10, 1954, does not fully set forth the operating authority granted by the Commission,

Therefore, good cause requiring,

IT IS ORDERED that paragraph (1) of the order in Decision No. 50398, on Application No. 35338, be and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity be and it hereby is granted to H-10 Water Taxi Company, Ltd., a corporation, authorizing the establishment and operation of a transportation service by vessel for the transportation of persons and property between docks, wharves, ships, points and places within the Los Angeles and Long Beach Harbors and between said docks, wharves, ships, points and places, on the one hand, and points and places on Catalina Island, excepting therefrom Avalon Bay, and all vessels departing from or arriving at said harbors, on the other hand, subject to the following conditions:

- (a) Applicant shall not transport any sightseeing passengers whose point of origin is within the Long Beach Harbor.
- (b) In the transportation of property as herein authorized applicant shall use the type of passenger-carrying vessels described in its Application No. 35338.

In all other respects Decision No. 50398 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
