## $\underline{O P I N I O N}$

Applicant, Helen C. McQuiggan, Administratrix of the Estate of Nicholas Capraro, doing business under the name of Palo Alto Transit, presently rendering a passenger stage service between points on the San Francisco peninsula, seeks authority to extend service to Mountain View.

Said extension would be approximately 5.6 miles and would allegedly serve as a feeder line from the suburban area of Mountain View to the depots of the Pacific Greyhound Lines and the Southern Pacific Company. Exhibit C attached to the application and made a part thereof sets forth the proposed fares. It is asserted that the proposed extension will permit applicant to turn dead mileage into revenue mileage.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion that public convenience and necessity require that the authority sought be granted. A public hearing does not appear to be necessary.

Application having been filed and the Commission informed in the premises,

## IT IS ORDERED:

1. That a certificate of public convenience and necessity be granted to Helen C. McQuiggan, Administratrix of the Estate of

Nicholas Capraro, doing business as the Palo Alto Transit, authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code, for the transportation of passengers between Los Altos and Mountain View.

2. That in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant shall comply with and observe the following regulations:

- a. Applicant shall file a written acceptance herein granted within thirty days after the effective date hereof.
- b. Within sixty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than five days notice to the Commission and to the public applicants shall file in triplicate and concurrently make effective appropriate tariffs and timetables.
- c. Subject to the authority of the Commission to change or modify it at any time by further order, applicants shall conduct the service herein authorized over and along the following route:

Commencing in the City of Los Altos at the intersection of Fremont Avenue and Miramonte Way thence along Miramonte Way, Berry Avenue, Springer Road, Emerson Avenue, Miramonte Avenue, Sladky Avenue, Springer Road, El Camino Real, Escuela Avenue, California Street, Castro Street, Front Street to its intersection with View Street.
