O R D E R

City of Sacramento is authorized to construct Front Street Extended at grade across a track of Southern Pacific Company in the City of Sacramento, Sacramento County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. AU-90.5. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing and grades of approach shall be substantially as shown on Exhibit A attached to the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflecting material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
