O R D E R

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct one spur track at grade in and along an unnamed alley and across Scovell Avenue in the City of San Jacinto, Riverside County, at the location described in the application. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Scovell Avenue is not improved at the point of crossing, and this authority shall not be construed as authorizing the opening of said street across the spur track.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or

if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
