OPINION AND ORDER

Pacific Gas and Electric Company,<sup>1/</sup> a corporation, by the above-numbered application filed August 4, 1954, asks the Commission for authority to carry out the terms and conditions of an agreement, dated July 28, 1954, with Willits Redwood Products Company,<sup>1/</sup> a corporation. A copy of the subject agreement is attached to the application as Exhibit A. The agreement provides, among other things, that Pacific will supply water through a single service connection to Customer for normal water requirements and for fire protection purposes at its plant located at the west end of Franklin Street in the City of Willits, Mendocino County.

Under the provisions of the agreement, Pacific will install, at its own expense, an 8-inch service connection from its main located in Franklin Street to a mutually agreed-upon point of delivery on Customer's property. Pacific is to make the connection at the point of delivery, and all equipment furnished and installed by Pacific will remain its property and will be maintained by it.

Further, under the terms of the agreement, Pacific will be responsible only to make available to Customer such water at such pressure as may be available at said point of delivery from time to time as a result of Pacific's normal operation of its Willits water distribution system. Charges for water delivered are to be determined as the sum of a fixed charge of \$15 per month and the amount computed by applying to the quantity used Pacific's regularly filed schedule of meter rates for its Willits water system or such applicable schedules as may be authorized by the Commission.

The agreement is proposed to become effective, if authorized by the Commission, from and after the last regular meter reading date preceding the Commission's order, and shall continue in force for a term of three years and thereafter until terminated by either party giving to the other a thirty-day written notice.

Said agreement contains the provision that it will at all times be subject to such changes or modifications by the Commission as it may from time to time direct in the exercise of its jurisdiction.

The Commission having considered the request of the applicant and being of the opinion that the application should be granted and that a public hearing is not necessary, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company be and it is authorized to carry out the terms and conditions of the written agreement, dated July 28, 1954, with Willits Redwood Products Company, and to render the water service described therein under the terms, charges and conditions stated therein.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall:

1. File with this Commission, within thirty days after the effective date of this order, two certified copies of the agreement as executed, together with a statement of the date on which the agreement is deemed to have become effective.
2. Notify this Commission of the date of termination of said agreement within thirty days after said date of termination.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
