O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct additional spur tracks at grade across Petroleum Street (near Terminal Street), Petroleum Street (near Orient Street) Terminal Street (near Petroleum Street), Terminal Street (near Pier Street), and Orient Street at Pier Street in the City of Oakland, Alameda County, at the locations described in the application. Crossings shall be identified and protected as summarized in the following table:

Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two percent. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

These spurs are proposed to serve the Port of Oakland facilities, and applicant alleges that the Port of Oakland has requested that this work be performed immediately.

Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
