between San Rafael and Vallejo via
the Black Point cutoff, as an
alternate route only.

O P I N I O N

Kellogg Express and Draying Co., presently conducting a highway common carrier service, among other points, between San Francisco, specified Marin County points and Vallejo and Napa and certain intermediate points, requests authority to operate between San Rafael and Vallejo via U. S. Highway 101 from San Rafael to its junction with State Highway 37 thence via State Highway 37 to its junction with State Highway 48 thence via State Highway 48 to its junction with State Highway 29, thence via State Highway 29 to Vallejo, as an alternate route for operating convenience only.

Applicant alleges that its operations, between San Francisco, Marin County points, and San Francisco Peninsula points, on the one hand, and Vallejo and Napa and intermediate points, on the other hand, by the use of the less congested route proposed herein, would be made more efficient, to the benefit of the shipping public.

Under the circumstances, the Commission is of the opinion that the application should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

An application having been filed and the Commission being of the opinion that the authority sought should be granted,

IT IS ORDERED that Kellogg Express and Draying Co., may conduct its highway common carrier operations between San Rafael and Vallejo, via U. S. Highway 101 from San Rafael to its junction with State Highway 37 thence via State Highway 37 to its junction with State Highway 48, thence via State Highway 48 to its junction with State Highway 29, thence via State Highway 29 to Vallejo, as an alternate route, for operating convenience only.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
