O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an additional spur track at grade across Ninth Street in the City of Gilroy, Santa Clara County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. E-80.8.

Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding four percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheeting. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The applicant has stated that the industry to be served by the proposed track requests that the track be installed as soon

as possible in order to expedite shipments of perishable products.

Consequently the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
