O R D E R

County of Contra Costa is authorized to construct Hartford Road at grade across a track of the San Ramon Branch of Southern Pacific Company near Alamo, Contra Costa County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. BO-53.5. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails.

Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than six percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflecting material.

Upon completion, the dirt farm grade crossing located at Mile Post 53.55 and the farm grade crossing located approximately 400 feet northwesterly from the proposed Hartford Road grade crossing shall be abandoned and closed by said Railroad. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity,

or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
