In the Matter of the Application of the County of Contra Costa, State of California, for a crossing at grade , Application No. 35773 of the tracks of the Southern Pacific Company at Hartford Road near Alamo, Contra Costa County, California.

## ORDER

County of Contra Costa is authorized to construct Hartford Road at grade across a track of the San Ramon Branch of Southern Pacific Company near Alaro, Contra Costa County, at the Iocation described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. BO-53.5. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of innes two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than six percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General order No. 72. Protection shali be by two Standard No. I crossing signs (General Oreer No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflecting matorial.

Upon completion, the dirt farm grade crossing located at Mile Post 53.55 and the farm grade crossing located approximately 400 foet northwesterly from tho proposed Hartford Road grade crossing shall be abandoned and closad by said Railroad. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shail so advise the Cominssion in writing. This authorization shail become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions arc not complicd with. Authorization mey be rovoked or modificd if public convenience, necessity,
or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
