O R D E R

County of Shasta is authorized to construct a temporary railroad crossing at grade across Shasta Route (Siskiyou) main line of Southern Pacific Company near Anderson, Shasta County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. C-251.1. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-four feet and grades of approach not greater than five percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B), reflectorized with reflex-reflecting material.

The County of Shasta plans within two years to construct a parallel road east of the Southern Pacific Company railroad track as stated in a resolution of the Board of Supervisors dated January 25, 1954. Construction of this road will make railroad grade crossing C-251.1 unnecessary. Therefore two years from the effective date of this order said railroad grade crossing shall be closed and removed by Southern Pacific Company.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
