BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Application of METROPOLITAN COACH LINES, a corporation, for authority to change the certificated route descriptions in the San Bernardino and Riverside areas so as to provide a through service to Redlands; and to make route modifications on lines effected by the Santa Ana Freeway construction in the City of Los Angeles.

OPINION

Applicant herein requests authority to extend its

Los Angeles-San Bernardino Line from its present terminal at

San Bernardino to Redlands, and to extend its Los AngelesRiverside Line from the present terminal at Riverside to San

Bernardino. In connection with these two extensions it is

requested that the said lines be designated as Route No. 60.

This will eliminate that portion of the present Route No. 63

easterly of Pomona. Authority is also requested to change

present Route No. 62, the Arlington-Riverside-San BernardinoRedlands Line by eliminating that portion of the line between

Riverside and Redlands which now is proposed to be served by

the new Route No. 60. Finally, authority is requested to amend

existing route descriptions so as to permit changes in operation

made necessary by the Santa Ana Freeway.

Attached to the application are four maps showing the present certificated routings and the proposed modifications

thereof, as well as the new Route No. 60. It is alleged that these modifications do not affect existing carriers in the area, and will result in no changes in fares. Likewise, the frequency of service will not be changed, with two exceptions. The present headway on the Riverside line is every hour and five minutes, and this will be shortened to every hour. On the service between Riverside, San Bernardino and Redlands there is approximately a forty-minute headway in the a.m. and p.m. peaks, which is proposed to be changed to an hourly service.

It is alleged that the applicant previously has furnished its Articles of Incorporation, and that complete financial data is available to the Commission in other applications of this company now pending before this Commission, as well as in its financial reports.

It is stated in the application that the proposed extension of the Los Angeles-San Bernardino Line to Redlands will eliminate the necessity of passengers transferring at San Bernardino and thereby provide a through service to Redlands. The proposed extension of the Los Angeles-Riverside Line to San Bernardino will permit an hourly frequency on this line, and likewise will provide thirty-minute service to and from San Bernardino and Pomona since these cities are served by both of the lines herein concerned. Likewise it will eliminate the present transfers necessary to travel between Los Angeles and Colton.

The construction work joining the Santa Ana and Hollywood Freeways in the vicinity of Los Angeles Union

Passenger Terminal has made it necessary for applicant to operate certain routes on detours. Now that this construction work is completed it is impossible for applicant to return to its original certificated routes and therefore changes are now proposed.

The Commission has been advised by the Department of Public Works of the State of California that there is no objection to the proposals providing applicant is not authorized to make any stops within the limits of any state freeway herein involved for the purpose of picking up or discharging passengers. Likewise the Cities of Riverside, San Bernardino, Redlands and Colton have advised that they have no objection to the proposal. In the light of this record it appears, and we now find, that public convenience and necessity require the proposed changes, and, accordingly, they will be authorized. A public hearing is not necessary.

ORDER

Application as above entitled having been filed, the Commission being fully advised in the premises and hereby finding that public convenience and necessity so require,

IT IS ORDERED that Metropolitan Coach Lines, a California corporation, is hereby authorized to (1) extend its present Los Angeles-San Bernardino Line from its present terminal at San Bernardino to Redlands, and to extend its Los Angeles-Riverside Line from its present terminal at Riverside to San Bernardino, and to designate these lines as Route No. 60;

LOS ANGELES-EL MONTE-BALDWIN PARK-COVINA-POMONA LINE

ROUTE NO. 63

POMONA VIA COVINA

(a) From Main Street Station at 6th and Main Streets (Los Angeles), via Main Street, Macy Street, Mission Road, Marengo Street, Fickett Street, Ramona Froeway, Garvey Avenue, Tyler Avenue (El Monte), Columbia Street, Valley Boulevard, Garvey Avenue, Baldwin Park Boulevard, Sierra Madre Boulevard, West Ramona Boulevard (Baldwin Park), East Ramona Boulevard, San Bernardino Road, 4th Street (Covina), Badillo Street, 2nd Street, San Bernardino Road, Grand Avenue, Covina Boulevard, Cataract Avenue (San Dimas), Bonita Avenue, 4th Street, (La Verne), Lincoln Avenue, Pomona Avenue, La Verne Avenue, and Garey Avenue to the Pomona Station at 4th and Garey Avenue (Pomona).

Return via reverse of above route to East Ramona Boulevard and Maine Avenue (Baldwin Park), thence via Maine Avenue, West Ramona Boulevard, Baldwin Park Boulevard, and reverse of above route to Ramona Freeway, thence via Ramona Freeway, Marengo Street, Mission Road, Macy Street, Alameda Street, Sunset Boulevard, Los Angeles Street, 6th Street, and Maple Avenue to the Los Angeles Terminal.

(b) From Main Street Station at 6th and Main Streets (Los Angeles), via route (a) to Garvey Avenue and Tylor Avenue, thence via Garvey Avenue to Valley Boulevard (Five Points), thence via route (a) to Pomona Station.

Return via reverse of above route to Tyler Avenue and Garvey Avenue (El Monte), thence via the return of route (a) to the Los Angeles Terminal.

EL MONTE-BALDWIN PARK

(c) From Main Street Station at 6th and Main Streets (Los Angeles), via route (a) to El Monte Station at Tyler Avenue and Columbia Street, thence via Columbia Street, San Bernardino Road, West Ramona Boulevard, Sierra Madre Boulevard, and West Ramona Boulevard to Maine Avenue (Baldwin Park).

Return via West Ramona Boulevard, San Bernardino Road, thence via return of above route to El Monte Station at Tyler Avenue and Columbia Street, thence via return of route (a) to the Los Angeles Terminal.

BROOKLYN AVENUE

(d) From Main Street Station at 6th and Main Streets (Los Angeles), via Main Street, Macy Street, Brooklyn Avenue, Atlantic Boulevard, Garvey Avenue, and Tyler Avenue to El Monte Station at Columbia Street (El Monte).

Return via reverse of above route to Macy Street, thence via return of route (a) to the Los Angeles Terminal.

POMONA FAIR
(Operated only to accommodate special events at the Fair-grounds)

(e) From Main Street Station at 6th and Main Streets (Los Angeles), via Main Street, Macy Street, Mission Road, Valley Boulevard (through Alhambra; San Gabriel and Rosemead to El Monte), Tyler Avenue; Columbia Street, Valley Boulevard (through Puente, Walnut, and Spadra), to Holt Avenue and Bellevue Avenue; or, from Los Angeles Terminal via Main Street, Macy Street, Mission Road, Marengo Street, Fickett Street, Ramona Freeway, Garvey Avenue (through Monterey Park and El Monte), Garvey Boulevard, Arroyo Avenue, U. S. Highway 99, to Holt Avenue and Bellevue Avenue, thence via Holt Avenue, White Avenue, Huntington Boulevard, and Fair Avenue to La Verne Avenue; also, from Huntington Boulevard and Fulton Road (Pomona), via Fulton Road to La Verne Avenue; also, from Pomona Station at 4th Street and Garey Avenue via Garey Avenue, Walnut Street, Berkeley Avenue, and Walnut Avenue to Fairgrounds Entrance Gate 1 near Canon Way.

Return via reverse of above routes, using return routes of (a), (b), and (c) from connecting points to the Los Angeles Terminal.

RESTRICTIONS:

No passengers, baggage, or express shall be transported in the City of Los Angeles when origin and destination are both points located on Marengo Street between Mission Road and Soto Street; nor on Route No. 63 (d) when origin and destination are between Main Street Station at 6th and Main Streets (Los Angeles), and any point west of intersection of Brooklyn and Rowan Avenues (Los Angeles).

No passengers shall be picked up or discharged along the Ramona Freeway.

j A. 35504 - MP LOS ANGELES-SIERRA MADRE LINE ROUTE NO. 67. From Main Street Station at 6th and Main Streets (Los Angeles), via Main Street, or, as an alternate, from Los Angeles Street Terminal (Los Angeles), via Los Angeles Street, Sixth Street, San Pedro Street, Commercial Street, Santa Ana Freeway, Mission Road, Huntington Drive, Main Street, Huntington Drive, San Marino Avenue, Sierra Madre Boulevard, and Mountain Trail Avenue to Highland Avenue (Sierra Madre). Return via Mountain Trail Avenue, Sierra Madre Boulevard, San Marino Avenue, Huntington Drive, Mission Road, Santa Ana Freeway, North Frontage Road, Los Angeles Street, 6th Street, and Maple Avenue to the Los Angeles Terminal. LOS ANGELES-MONROVIA-GLENDORA LINE ROUTE NO. 68. From Main Street Station at 6th and Main Streets (Los Angeles), via Main Street, or, as an alternate, from Los Angeles Street Terminal (Los Angeles), via Los Angeles Street, Sixth Street, San Pedro Street, Commercial Street, Santa Ana Freeway, Mission Road, Huntington Drive, Main Street, Huntington Drive, Holly Avenue, Huntington Drive, First Avenue (Arcadia), Colorado Boulevard, Mayflower Avenue (Monrovia), Olive Avenue, Shamrock Avenue, Huntington Drive, Foothill Boulevard (through Duarte and Azusa), Citrus Avenue, and Foothill Boulevard to Michigan Avenue (Glendora). Return via reverse of above route to Holly Avenue and Huntington Drive, thence via Huntington Drive, Mission Road, Santa Ana Freeway, North Frontage Road, Los Angeles Street, 6th Street, and Maple Avenue to the Los Angeles Terminal. LOS ANGELES-HELLMAN AVENUE LINE ROUTE NO. 69. From Main Street Station at 6th and Main Streets (Los Angeles), via Main Street, or, as an alternate, from Los Angeles Street Terminal (Los Angeles), via Los Angeles Street, 6th Street, San Pedro Street, Commercial Street, Santa Ana Freeway, Ramona Freeway, Hellman-Fremont Avenues Frontage Road, Hellman Avenue, and Walnut Grove Avenue to Garvey Avenue. -9-

From Main Street Station at 6th and Main Streets (Los Angeles), via Main Street, or, as an alternate, from Los Angeles Street Terminal (Los Angeles), via Los Angeles Street, 6th Street, San Pedro Street, Commercial

A. 35504 - MP/S Street, Santa Ana Freeway, Mission Road, Marengo Street, Soto Street, Huntington Drive, and Main Street to Private Property Parking Lot at Sierra Vista. Return via Huntington Drive, Monterey Road, Huntington Drive, Soto Street, Marengo Street, Mission Road, Santa Ana Freeway, North Frontage Road, Los Angeles Street, 6th Street, and Maple Avenue to the Los Angeles Terminal. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, Metropolitzn Coach Lines shall comply with and observe the following service regulations: (a) Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted. (b) Within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and upon not less than five days! notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate, and concurrently make effective, appropriate tariffs and timetables satisfactory to the Commission.
