O P I N I O N

Applicant W. A. Peppers, doing business as Napa Transit Company, requests authority to discontinue service as a common carrier for the transportation of passengers in the vicinity of Napa, as authorized by Decision No. 44299 dated June 13, 1950 in Application No. 31377.

As justification for the authority sought applicant alleges that he discontinued service as of May 1954 because of insufficient passenger revenue and inability to acquire the necessary public liability insurance.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion that public convenience and necessity no longer require a continuance of the service herein considered.

O R D E R

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED that the operative rights granted by Decision No. 44299 dated June 13, 1950 in Application No. 31377, are hereby revoked, cancelled and annulled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of W. A. Peppers, doing business as Napa Transit Company, are hereby cancelled.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
