ORDER

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct State Route 127 at grade across the Keeler Branch of Southern Pacific Company in the County of Inyo, in the manner described in Exhibit "A" and at the location as shown on Exhibit "C" attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. ANA-571.3. Width of crossing shall be not less than 28 feet and grades of approach not greater than two per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1-A crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B).

Applicant is also authorized to widen State Route 127 across the Owenyo Branch of Southern Pacific Company (Crossing No. BAM-516.1) to a width of not less than 28 feet, with grades of approach not greater than one per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, and protection shall be by two Standard No. 1-A crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B).

Construction expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between applicant and Southern Pacific Company, and a copy of said executed agreement shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction by further order.

Applicant shall bear maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.

Within thirty days after completion of each crossing pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
