ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Jensen Street in the City of Oakland, Alameda County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. D-10.77-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street as graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one percent. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G. O. No. 75-B). Applicant is authorized to deviate from the provisions of Section 3.17 of the Commission's G. O. No. 26-D effective February 1, 1948, in the construction of said track provided that all other clearances prescribed in said general order be maintained. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.
