FOURTEENTH SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant transports wrought iron pipe for Crane & Company between specified points in the City and County of San Francisco. Prior orders in this proceeding have authorized applicant to deviate from the minimum rate otherwise applicable to this transportation. The authority is scheduled to expire October 31, 1954. The latest extension was granted August 24, 1954 by Decision No. 50465. In said decision the Commission concluded that applicant's request for a year's extension did not appear justified without further investigation.

By the present supplemental application it is alleged that because of the illness and on October 10, 1954, the death of Mr. J. A. Clark, an executive officer of the applicant corporation, in charge of its activities in this area, applicant has been unable to prepare this proceeding for hearing. An additional extension of the present basis to and including December 31, 1954, is requested to provide time for hearing and determination by the Commission of this application. This request will be granted. To prevent a lapse of applicant's authority, the order will be made effective November 1, 1954.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the expiration date of the authority granted J. A. Clark Draying Company, Ltd., by Decision No. 43242 of August 23, 1949, as amended, be, and it is hereby extended to December 31, 1954, unless sooner changed or further extended by order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective November 1, 1954.
