FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Asbury Rapid Transit System, by the application herein, among other things requests authority to route its downtown Los Angeles terminus operation inbound from the intersection of New High Street and Sunset Boulevard, via Sunset Boulevard, Los Angeles Street, and Eleventh Street to on-street parking thereon between Los Angeles Street and Main Street. Outbound service will be from the on-street parking place on Eleventh Street, via Eleventh Street, Main Street and Spring Street to New High Street. Applicant proposes inbound to discharge no passengers south of Eighth Street, and outbound to pick up no passengers south of Ninth Street. Through inadvertence the requested restrictions were omitted from Decision No. 50575 which granted to applicant the terminus routing requested by the application herein.

Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that Paragraph (2) of the order of Decision No. 50575 be, and the same hereby is, amended to read as follows:

(2) That the route description of Asbury Transit Lines' Los Angeles terminus, contained in Decision No. 40982, as amended by Decision No. 44783 and Decision No. 49274, is amended to read as follows:

Inbound:

From the intersection of New High Street, Spring Street, and Sunset Boulevard, via Sunset Boulevard, Los Angeles Street and Eleventh Street to an on-street parking zone on Eleventh Street between Los Angeles Street and Main Street.

Outbound:

Via Eleventh Street, Main Street, and Spring Street to the intersection of New High Street, Spring Street, and Sunset Boulevard,

provided that Asbury Rapid Transit System may not pick up passengers south of Ninth Street northbound, or discharge passengers south of Eighth Street southbound.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, except as herein changed, the provisions of Decision No. 50575 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
