ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

It appearing by Decision No. 48716, dated June 16, 1953, in Application No. 34420, that G. E. Williams was authorized to establish and operate a service as a passenger stage corporation for the transportation of passengers and their baggage between Pines Village and Wishon and intermediate points in the vicinity of Bass Lake, Madera County, seasonally between the approximate dates of May 15 and September 15 in each year; that no evidence of adequate protection against liability imposed by law for the payment of damages for personal injury or property damage has been filed with the Commission by said G. E. Williams, as required by General Order No. 101; and it further appearing after investigation by this Commission that the above-described passenger service has not been established as prescribed by said Decision No. 48716; therefore, it is hereby found that G. E. Williams, after having been duly granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity, has failed to establish service thereunder.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to G. E. Williams by Decision No. 48716 in the above-entitled proceeding is hereby revoked, and all effective tariffs and timetables filed by said G. E. Williams are hereby canceled.

The Secretary of the Commission is hereby directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon G. E. Williams.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after lawful service of a copy hereof upon G. E. Williams, unless said G. E. Williams before such effective date shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order, denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order will thereby be stayed until hearing is held and further order issued.
