ORDER OF DISMISSAL

In this proceeding, complainant alleges that the service provided by defendant in the Washington Manor area near San Leandro is inadequate and seeks an order directing defendant to reroute certain of its lines so as to provide satisfactory additional service. During the course of the hearing held in this matter in Oakland on July 21, 1954, before Commissioner Verne Scoggins and Examiner Henry Jacopi, representatives of complainant and defendant reached an agreement relative to service adjustments designed to satisfy the transportation requirements of the residents of the Washington Manor area. Upon request of the parties further hearing of the matter was postponed.

More extensive service is now being provided in the area in question. In the circumstances, complainant has requested

in writing that the complaint be dismissed.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the complaint in Case No. 5502 be and it is hereby dismissed.
