O R D E R

The Town of Corte Madera is authorized to construct a pedestrian path at grade across a branch line track of Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company in Corte Madera, Marin County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 5C-12.3-D. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than six feet and grades of approach shall be by suitable stairs and pathway as indicated by Exhibit "A" in the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 1 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign. (G.O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
