O R D E R

City of Sacramento is authorized to construct a pedestrian crossing at grade across the main line track of Central California Traction Company near 73rd Street in the City of Sacramento, Sacramento County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 61-45.2-D. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Central California Traction Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not greater than six feet and grades of approach not greater than six percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 1 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G.O. No. 75-B). A turnstile shall be installed and maintained at expense of applicant at each right-of-way fence.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or

safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
