O R D E R

The Holton Inter-Urban Railway Co. is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across County Road #21 in the County of Imperial at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 49-701.8-C. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without super-elevation and of a minimum width of 30 feet, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding 5%. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B).

Within 30 days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so requires.

Applicant declares that the industry to be served now faces its peak annual operations and requests that the order be made effective on its date. For this reason the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
