O R D E R

The City of Los Angeles is authorized to construct Fair Avenue at grade across the Burbank Branch of Southern Pacific Company in the City of Los Angeles, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. BY-463.0. Construction expense shall be borne in accordance with an existing blanket agreement between the City of Los Angeles and Southern Pacific Company. Maintenance cost between lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by Southern Pacific Company. Maintenance cost outside such lines shall be borne by applicant. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than five per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within

one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
