O P I N I O N

Decision No. 50543, in Application No. 35745, dated September 14, 1954, authorized Charles F. Hushbeck to operate as a passenger stage corporation within the City of Watsonville, and between Watsonville and territory immediately adjacent thereto, and provided for the conduct of such operation over three routes.

Applicant now seeks authority to establish a fourth route within the City of Watsonville, alleging that:

1. There is a public demand for the proposed route.
2. The proposed route runs through a heavily populated residential district in which there is no means of public transportation.
3. There will be no change in the fares, rules and regulations presently on file.

The application will be granted.

O R D E R

An application having been filed and the Commission being of the opinion that the authority requested should be granted,

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 50543, dated September 14, 1954, at ordering paragraph 2.c. is amended by the addition of the following:

"Route 4

"Commencing at the City Plaza on Main Street between Third and Peck Streets in Watsonville, California; thence northwesterly on Main Street to East Lake Avenue; thence northeasterly on East Lake Avenue to Lincoln Street; thence northwesterly on Lincoln Street to Stanford Street; thence northeasterly on Stanford Street to Monte Vista Avenue; thence northwesterly on Monte Vista Avenue to Montecito Street; thence northeasterly on Montecito Street to Brewington Avenue; thence southeasterly on Brewington Avenue to Stanford Street; thence northeasterly on Stanford Street to Tuttle Avenue; thence easterly on Tuttle Avenue to East Lake Avenue; thence southerly on East Lake Avenue to Hushbeck Avenue; thence southeasterly on Hushbeck Avenue to Third Street; thence southwestwesterly on Third Street to the City Plaza and point of beginning."

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof. ✓
