## OPINION

Applicant is onc of tho group of carriors whoso problems procipitatcd the invostigation designatod by tho Commission as Caso No. 5535. Hearings woro hold on this application in connoction with that caso. Evidoncs of community growth and the rosulting oxpansion of carrior operetions, es doveloped in Caso No. 5535; was found to npply to this applicant and to have matoriaily influonced his activitios. In addition, a hearing on this appication alono was held bofore Bxaminer John Powor in San Frencisco on Juiy $26,2954$. On that occasion applicent prescnted ovidonce covering the history, finances, oquipnont, facilitios and porsonncl of his organization. C. N. Batos tostificd he has hed ebout 25 years of oxperience in truck transportation. Enriy in 1943 he wont into businoss for himscif, purchasing one truck and doing all the work
himsclf. He presentiy has aine omploycos and cight pieces of oquipment and estimetes thet 40 por cont of his business is now transbay.

Applicent's terminal contains 37,500 square fect of yard space, 26,000 square foct of dock space and adequate office facilities.

A balance sheet exhibit introduced by applicent shows assets of $\$ 26,024$, incluaing $\$ 11,285$ of current assets; the current linbilities were: $\$ 490$. Operations in 1953 showed revenue of
\$85,256, exponses of $\$ 66,741$ and a gross profit of $\$ 18,515$. The revenue, expense and profit figures for the years 1949 through 1952 wore given in enother exhibit as follows:

spplicant has acquircd sevon unts of revonue equipment and a service car since January 1, 1949. All oight woro acquircd for cosh.

The operating method of applicant is to provide delivory sorvice across the bridge twico a day with additional sorvice as neoded.

The npplicant's troffic exhibit as summarized in Exhibit 17 in Cnso 5535 shows 2,077 shipments of 1,099,265 pounds in 71 days reported or 29 shipments por dey. Average weight handied came to 25,483 pounds por doy, 325,143 pounds por month and $3,901,726$ pounds per yonr for a long list of customers. Six of those eustomers tostificd in support of the applicetion. They represented companies Erom the following trades or industries: tire and rubber, pot foods and supplies, metaliurgy ind plastics, sanitary and related supplies, toilotrics and boauty shop supplios, and gasoline sorvico station suppiios.

The evidence shows that applicant has the nocessary finoncinl ablifty, focilitios, oquipment, oxporionco and porsonncl to undertaise the proposed serwice. It furthor shows that the growth of tho San Francisco-East Bay communtios has incroascd the over-all requircments for common carrior sorvilec and hes resulted in incroased domand for applicant's serwices. Public convenionce and nocossity roquifo thret tho appication bo grantod. This grant will bo on the condition, howovor, that npplicnet sorve tho whole of the San Francisco-East Bay cartage zono as established in Caso No. 5535. licecptance of tho cortificetc heroin granted will be construod as consont to this condition.
l.pplicont $1 s$ placod upon notico that operetivo rights, as such, do not constituto a class of property which may be copitalized or used as an olement of value in rate fixing for any mount of monoy in excess of that originaliy paid to the state as the consideration for the grant of such rights. Aside from thoir purcly pormissive aspect, thoy extond to the holder a full or partini monopoly of a clase of business over a particular routo. This monopoly foeturc mey be changod or dostroyod at any time by the stato, which is not in any rospoct limitod as to tho mumben of rights which may bo givon.

## ORDER

Applicetion having boon filod and public hoarings hold thercon, and tho commission heving considerod the some and boing of tho opinion and finding that public convonionco and necossity so require; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED:
(1) That a contificnto of public convonionco and nocossity is heroby grantod to C. N. Bates, doing businoss as C. N. Bates

Droyage, authorizine the ostablisherent and oporation of a sorvice os a highwoy comon carricr, as defince in Scction 213 of the Public Utilities Code, for the transportation of general commodities except petroleum products in bulk in tank venicles, dangerous explosives and iivestock, between the points set forth in Appendx " 4 ". attached hereto and by this reference made a part of this ordor.
(2) Thet in proviaing service pursuant to the authority herein granted, applicant may use any and all strects, roads, highways and bridges, and shall comply with the following service regulations:
a. Within thirty days after the offective datc of this order, applicant shall file a written acceptanco of tho cortificatc hercin grantod.
b. Within sixty days after the offoctive date heroor, and upon not less than ilve days' notice to tho Commiesion and the public, applicant shall ostablish the sorvice horein authorizod and comply with the provisions of Genorai Ordor No. 80 by filing in triplicate, and concurrentiy making offective, tarifis satisfoctory to the Commission.
