Application of the County of Riverside, a political subdivision of the State of California, having corporate powers, for an order to construct a public highway across a railroad.

Application No. 35581

ORDER

The County of Riverside is authorized to construct Cleveland Street at grade across the El Paso Route of Southern Pacific Company near Mecca, Riverside County, at the location described in the application as amended November 15, 1954, to be identified as Crossing No. B-630.9. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than two per cont. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B).

Upon completion, Crossing No. B-630.0, Arthur Street, about nine-tenths of a mile to the west, shall be abandoned and closed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This

authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
